<p>13 Behold, My servant will prosper, He will be high and lifted up and [u]greatly exalted.</p> <p>14 Just as many were astonished at you, <i>My people</i>, So His appearance was marred more than any man And His form more than the sons of men.</p> <p>15 Thus He will sprinkle many nations, Kings will shut their mouths on account of Him; For what had not been told them they will see, And what they had not heard they will understand</p> <p>1 Who has believed our message? And to whom has the arm of the LORD been revealed?</p> <p>2 For He grew up before Him like a tender [u]shoot, And like a root out of parched ground; He has no <i>stately</i> form or majesty That we should look upon Him, Nor appearance that we should [u]be attracted to Him.</p> <p>3 He was despised and forsaken of men, A man of [u] we did not esteem Him.</p> <p>4 Surely our [u]griefs He Himself bore, And our [u]sorrows He carried; Yet we ourselves sorrows and acquainted with [u]grief; And like one from whom men hide their face He was despised, and esteemed Him stricken, [u]Smitten of God, and afflicted.</p> <p>5 But He was [u]pierced through for our transgressions, He was crushed for our iniquities; The chastening for our [u]well-being <i>fell</i> upon Him, And by His scourging we are healed.</p> <p>6 All of us like sheep have gone astray, Each of us has turned to his own way; But the LORD has caused the iniquity of us all To [u]fall on Him.</p>	<p>7 He was oppressed and He was afflicted, Yet He did not open His mouth; Like a lamb that is led to slaughter, And like a sheep that is silent before its shearers, So He did not open His mouth.</p> <p>8 By oppression and judgment He was taken away; And as for His generation, who considered That He was cut off out of the land of the [u]living For the transgression of my people, to whom the stroke <i>was due</i>?</p> <p>9 His grave was assigned with wicked men, Yet He was with a rich man in His death, Because He had done no violence, Nor was there any deceit in His mouth.</p> <p>10 But the LORD was pleased To crush Him, [u]putting <i>Him</i> to grief; If [u]He would render Himself as a guilt offering, He will see <i>His</i> [u]offspring, He will prolong <i>His</i> days, And the [u]good pleasure of the LORD will prosper in His hand.</p> <p>11 As a result of the [u]anguish of His soul, He will see [u]<i>it and</i> be satisfied; By His knowledge the Righteous One, My Servant, will justify the many, As He will bear their iniquities.</p> <p>12 Therefore, I will allot Him a portion with the great, And He will divide the booty with the strong; Because He poured out [u]Himself to death, And was numbered with the transgressors; Yet He Himself bore the sin of many, And interceded for the transgressors</p>
